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141/2020 ESCC Report

Councillors have received the previously circulated report from ESCC. East Sussex has currently 369 per 100,000cases of covid-19 and 66 new cases since the last report. Comparatively it is still low compared to the rest of the Country.

There has been some clarification from the Government on the test and trace app. People have been reluctant to download the app possibly because they are reluctant to give information. The information is anonymous and the app can't force people to self isolate, or identify the user to make them self isolate. It cannot be used to trace your location for law enforcement. It is hoped that the app will encourage people to self isolate when notified.

ESCC are encouraging parents to carry on the immunization process for their children. The vaccination numbers have dropped off and it is really important that this process continues. An 18 month scheme to improve street lighting, which will reduce council energy bills and lower carbon emissions, started in the middle of October. Additional funding has been secured enabling East Sussex Highways to upgrade 16,000 street light units to high efficiency LED. These are being placed in the towns such as Bexhill and not in the Villages.

At the end of October the Engineering Workshop at Peters Green was broken into and quite a lot stolen. The Office at Court Lodge was also targeted and the petty cash taken. Scenes of Crime Officers did attend and the PCSO notified.

147/2020 Recreation Ground – Bodiam Primary School

The Council has been approached by Bodiam Primary School requesting permission for a camp of a few tents on the Recreation Ground for one night in the summer term. Normally pupils would go further afield to Blacklands near East Grinstead but as the situation re covid-19 is still uncertain it was thought staying local would be a better option. Camp to be allowed- Proposed, Cllr Mitchell, Seconded, Cllr Napper and Cllr Stevens.

148/2020 Woodland Proposal-Recreation Ground

Following on from last month's meeting a quote had been obtained to determine how much it would be to mow a reduced sized Recreation Ground if this proposal goes ahead. The Council are still awaiting a report from Luke Everitt from the Woodland Trust re leaf fall report on other Recreation Grounds already under this scheme, to give some idea of damage to the grass and ongoing cost.

The Clerk has made enquiries to other Rother Clerks to see if there are other Councils with responsibility for Trees and will ask for other quotes from Tree Surgeon Companies. To be continued on next month's agenda.
