Vision and Values

At Bodiam Church of England Primary School, part of the Riverside Federation, our vision is to nurture a Christian community where every pupil feels valued, inspired, and prepared for life in an ever-changing world. We are guided by the values of **Compassion, Friendship, Tolerance, and Aspiration**, and we strive to live by the teaching to "love our neighbour as ourselves" (Mark 12:31).

Key Priorities and Progress

Over the past year, we have focused on several strategic priorities:

- Curriculum Enrichment: Our curriculum has been enhanced with enriching experiences
 including trips to Knole House, Drusillas, the White Rock Theatre, the Imperial War
 Museum, and a planned visit to the British Museum. We also welcomed the Hastings
 Sinfonia Orchestra for a live performance.
- **Inclusive Practice**: Our inclusive approach has been recognised as a model of good practice and shared with other local schools.
- **Attendance and Behaviour**: Attendance remains in line with national averages, and behaviour across the school continues to be exceptional.
- **SIAMS Inspection**: We were delighted to receive a very positive SIAMS inspection in November. The full report is available on our website.
- **Early Years Excellence**: Our Early Years provision continues to be outstanding and is also being used as a model for other schools.
- **Growing School Community**: We've welcomed 15 in-year admissions since September, with more expected after the half-term break and a projected 15 new Reception pupils joining in September 2025.

Celebrating Success

Our school community has much to be proud of:

- Charity and Community Engagement: We raised funds for Young Minds and Children in Need, and made generous donations to the Hastings Food Bank during Harvest and Advent.
- **Public Recognition**: Pupils participated in the Kent & East Sussex Railway Remembrance Service, which was featured on local and national news.
- **Sporting Achievements**: Our students competed successfully in football, netball, gymnastics, and cross-country events.
- **Creative Highlights**: A Year 1 pupil's Christmas card design was chosen as the cover for our local MP's card to the King.
- **Literacy and Learning**: Selected pupils attended a writer's workshop with author Ed Boxall, and we celebrated World Book Day with a creative "dress as a word" theme.
- **Community Events**: Our open mornings and family breakfast events were well-attended and warmly received.
- **Environmental and Outdoor Learning**: We participated in the RSPB's Big School Birdwatch and are in the process of preparing "Cluckingham Palace," a new outdoor learning space complete with a chicken run and allotment.
- **Digital Transformation**: We've modernised our communications, moving to digital newsletters and a digital prospectus, which has been positively received by parents.
