County Cllr Maynard reported that the Government Settlement was better than expected but it is not a 3-year settlement and there is no Green paper regarding Adult Social Care. Cllr Maynard suggested a 'Walkround' with the Highways steward which he is happy to attend.

**Speed Watch:** Meeting at RALC in October. There was a pre-meeting in September hosted by Catsfield Parish Council to try to find solutions to speeding. At the RALC meeting, attended by the police and Highways, there were more reasons given why suggestions could not be carried out than positive answers. When the Speedwatch team had been out this month there were 2 repeat offenders, both doing 45mph with no attempt to slow down. 200 cars in 1 hour and 300 cars in one hour. Highways are more interested in KSI statistics than in the social effects of speeding. A steering group is to be set up, Cllr Wey to be a member.
