Brede Parish Council had the following reasons for objecting

Layout and Density - Council felt there was over development of the site, with the density of the proposed houses being too high, they are in too close a proximity to each other. This is not in keeping with the current rural layout of the fringes of the village.

Nature Conservation - The nearby pond indicates the area is an informal flood area and it has a known history of flooding. The proposed sewage works are below ground level (as per design) and as such, due to the known history of flooding, there is a risk of the pond overflowing into the sewage pumping station, including the surface water tank. This will cause cross contamination and the pumping station will spill into the drainage ditch and surrounding area, causing damage to the environment and wildlife.

Traffic. The transport report is inaccurate as regards public transport and facilities. Occupants of the new houses will need cars and Council has concerns about the increased number of access roads in close proximity in the area and the increased volume of traffic.
