The clerk had been contacted by a resident and infirmed that children were accessing the ponds over the back of the recreations ground, following the cut back of overgrown brambles and grass. As the clerk was on leave at this time, Cllr Hampson investigated and found there was a significant gap which was indeed allowing access

Due to the concerns for the children's safety, Council need to discuss whether a small piece of fencing should be installed, by the council, to prevent such access. Councillors may wish to consider some signage, such as private land/no access/deep water.
