<u>Item 11</u>

The Black Cat recordings have been circulated. Council will need to discuss the findings and decide if there is any further actions required.

<u>Item 12</u>

Applications for grants of £400 each towards the maintenance of the two cemeteries in the Parish have been received and circulated. There is a budget for this.

<u>Item 13</u>

Two trees had to be removed from the recreation ground this spring and one last year. One Oak tree was planted for the Queens Jubilee. Council need to decide if further trees should be considered. Suitable trees should be available, with stake and delivery for around £100-£120 each. Planting time October to March.

Council may also wish to consider some new hedging where the fence repair has taken place. Hedging costs around £2-£5 per piece for 70-80cm stock. Planting time November to March

<u>Item 14</u>

The date and time for the Parish Assembly for 2023 need to be decided.

A Parish Assembly is the meeting for the residents and must meet between the 1st March and 1st June and it cannot start before 6pm.

As 2023 is election year, it would be advisable to have the Parish Assembly before election day, (4th May), but not too close to avoid the period of purdah.

A date in March may be best. The Council meeting will be on the 28th March, perhaps the 22nd would be suitable. (Wednesdays evenings are available at the Village Hall.)

<u>Item 15</u>

Announcement of the Garden Competition winners. Due to the high temperatures the judging was delayed and there will not be time to invite the winners to the July meeting to receive their prizes. Instead it is suggested that Cllr Nottage and the Clerk arrange a date to deliver the prizes and take a picture of the prize-winners in their gardens. Council need to receive the winners details and agree a date.
