I'm happy to report great improvements this time round – thanks to Eleanor's persistence in getting members of the Highways Department to engage. Sam has previously circulated minutes of our meeting with Highways held on 31 May, and an update from Ruby Brittle concerning quality control but recent works both completed and planned in summary:

Drains

- Camera survey and jetting of drains down Cackle Street along with identification/logging of all assets - completed
- Ditto drains on Deer Park Road/Stacey's Corner completed
- B2096 by Giffords Farm placement of alternative gully to prevent frequent build-up of silt –
 planned
- Work to collapsed road surface surrounding drain outside Turner's Farm/Oast planned

Re-surfacing work

 Greatly improved standards of patching on Cackle Street) completed
 Brightling Road) "
 Brickyard Lane) "

Highways are currently unable to comment on the financial programme for next year and so it is unknown whether badly-needed re-surfacing work on Rectory Hill is planned. We have stressed it is an extreme hazard.
