HURST GREEN PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the Meeting held in Hurst Green Village Hall on Tuesday 27th November 2018 starting at 8:00pm.

Present:- Councillor Browne (Chair), Councillor Brown, Councillor Kenchington, Councillor Price and District Councillor Prochak.

The RFO, David Hilbourne and the Clerk were in attendance. No public present.

1.0 Apologies for Absence: - Councillor Duddridge (*prior engagement*), Councillor Janes (*away*), Councillor Johnson (*prior engagement*), Councillor Wright (*hospital visit*) and County Councillor Barnes (*unwell*).

2.0 Minutes of the last meeting: -

To sign as a correct record the minutes of the meeting held on the Tuesday 30th October 2018 **Minutes proposed by Councillor Kenchington and seconded by Councillor Brown.**

Councillor Brown gave the report which included news on successful grant money rec'd, parking survey and SEA screening request sent in to Rother District Council

Councillor Browne noted that the Steering Group was doing incredibly well with a lot of progress made. 5.2 Older Persons Christmas Dinner (*Cllr. Johnson*)

This agenda item was not discussed as an anonymous donor has already funded this.

5.3 <u>WW1 silhouette and any resolutions associated with this (Cllr Browne)</u>

Councillor Brown proposed the motion that the Parish Council should pay £50 to the British Legion for the silhouette. This was seconded by Councilor Kenchington.

This motion was unanimously supported

As previously agreed Councilors, the RFO and Clerk would all contribute £10 to the remaining cost. 5.4 Clerk's report – *circulated*

6.0 TRANSPORT, ROADS & FOOTPATHS

It was reported that a child had been knocked down on the A21 pedestrian crossing on the 17^{th} November.

6.1 Community Speedwatch Initiative report

Councillor Kenchington reported that training was being done in December with a proposed start date of January 2019

6.2 <u>Motion to support the commissioning of a detailed traffic movement survey on the A21 at an</u> <u>approximate cost of £630</u> Due to Councillor Brown's work in decoding all the information from various Highways England devices it was felt that this agenda item should be put on hold until other resources have been fully explored. Councillors requested that this money should however be earmarked in the precept for speeding issues. 6.3 Discussion and any resolutions to support additional expenditure for verge grass cutting in 2019.

Due to the small area that the extra cuts involved it **was unanimously resolved** to go with the **two cuts offered** and monitor the results for the following year.

If Rother District Council however covers any additional cuts the Council resolved to support this for the parish.

RR/2018/2365/P - Planters Farm Shop - Land adjacent to, London Road, Hurst Green TN19 7QS. Change of use of redundant commercial land and erection of a pair of 3 bed dwellings and a pair of 2 bed dwellings. **Refused.**

RR/2018/2243/P - 64 London Road, Rosemount, Hurst Green TN19 7PN. Proposed single storey rear extension and internal alterations.. **Refused.**

RR/2018/2927/P - Boarzell Cottage, London Road, Hurst Green TN19 7QY. Extension to existing domestic garage. Two for, & two abstentions (diagrams unclear but no problem in principle). RR/2018/2737/P - 66 London Road, Lilly Joes Cottage, Hurst Green TN19 7PN. New window and revised internal layout to the ground floor and first-floor flat roof rear extension above the kitchen area. Not supported (concern about impact on neighbours as very dominating).
