7.3 <u>Resolution to approve Parish Council Pension Policy and Redeployment and Redundancy Policy</u>

David Hilbourne explained the background to this with new legislation meaning that the Council has to prepare and agree new employment policies for Hurst Green Parish Council.

Using Rother District Council's updated policies as a guide the RFO prepared and circulated the proposed policies to Councillors before the meeting and asked for formal consent to these policies.

The **resolution** to approve the Parish Council Pension and Redeployment and Redundancy Policies was formally **agreed** and **unanimously passed** by the Council at this meeting.

8.0 Playing & Stage Fields:-

Councillor Browne has moved the damaged bin from Lodge Field.

Councillor Greenfield reported that the fence and stile at the entrance to Stage Field needed to be repaired as someone had removed a section of fence and the stile was damaged. Councillors Greenfield and Browne will arrange this.

Councillor Greenfield has been speaking to the Hurst Green junior football club about the use of Stage Field but the Club do not think it will be a suitable venue now due to the entrance and road.

8.1 Lodge Field Play Equipment Inspection report 2014

Some problems have been identified in the report with the new equipment that was passed on completion of the project last year. Councillor Janes will look for the Inspection Report which Sovereign arranged after installation of the equipment and contact them re conflicting reports.

Councillor Peacock reported that a contractor working on the A21 said that it was known that the road was the worst constructed trunk road in the country and needed constant repairs.

Query about when the pedestrian crossing lights would be properly restored after being smashed into by a passing car. Clerk will check.
