<u>RR/2021/3069/T</u>	Brockhurst, Burgh Hill, Hurst Green TN19 7PE	Sycamore: Reduce crown in height and width proportionally by approximately 20%. Copper Beech: Reduce in height and width proportionately by approximately 25% and reduce phototrophic limbs growing over house by an additional 2-3m. Beech: Reduce in height and width by approximately 25% and reduce phototrophic limbs growing over house by an additional 2-3m. Poplar: Reduce in height by approx. 2-3m. Beech: Carry out 15-20% width reduction.
