## Hurst Green Neighbourhood Plan Update October 2022 - Supporting Paper

- 1. Following the Parish Council's decision at its last meeting, on the 28th September a grant for £8,335 was applied for from the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities. This also included support to update the Council's approved Masterplan and approved Design Codes as needed.
- 2. Following the Parish Council's decision at its last meeting, the RFO has returned the unspent funds from grant # NPG-12876 to the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities.
- 3. As of the 19th October 2022, the above grant had not yet been awarded, therefore work on analysing the representations has not yet begun.

## For discussion/decision:

- 4. As previously reported, the Council has not received any representation from its neighbouring parish, Etchingham does the Council wish the Clerk to follow up around this with Etchingham's Clerk?
- 5. Is the Council aware of any further regulation 14 representations that have been received that need to be shared with Councilors and the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group?
- 6. To pass the following motion: "That this council for reasons of complying with the terms of its grant award, will following all valid expenditure under grant #NPG-11380, instruct the RFO to return in short order any unspent sum to the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities.

## For noting:

7. According to the latest statistics from the Department for Levelling Up, Housing and Communities, four authorities, including RDC, have failed to meet the threshold for quality of planning decision-making. This potentially puts RDC at risk of a 'special measures' designation, which could see housing developers and site promoters being able to submit their planning applications directly to the Planning Inspectorate.
