Community Resilience Plan

Summary of the matter to be discussed

The Civil Contingencies Act 2004 (Contingency Planning) Regulations 2005 (as amended) requires all local authorities to have considered and planned for an emergency in their community, this plan should be held in a formal plan that details clearly actions to be taken to help respond to any said emergency.

The Parish currently does not have an in-date or relevant plan yet faces a number of emergencies each year.

Details of any considered or known options:

Option 1: Do nothing – this option is discounted as it does not meet the requirements of the Civil Contingencies Act 2004 (Contingency Planning) Regulations 2005 (as amended)

Option 2: Utilise District Council plan – this option is discounted as it does not provide the level of detail required in relation to the Parish

Option 3: Develop Parish plan

It is recommended that we proceed with option 3, the basis of a plan has been circulated with this paper however it is further recommended that a group of people are assembled to finalise this plan and engage with the community and other parish councils to prepare ahead of winter 2023.
