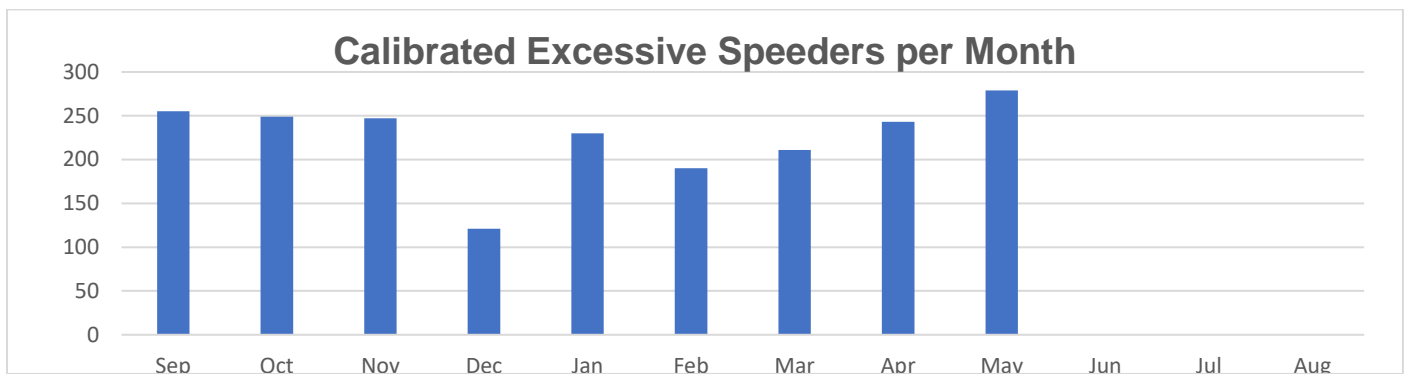
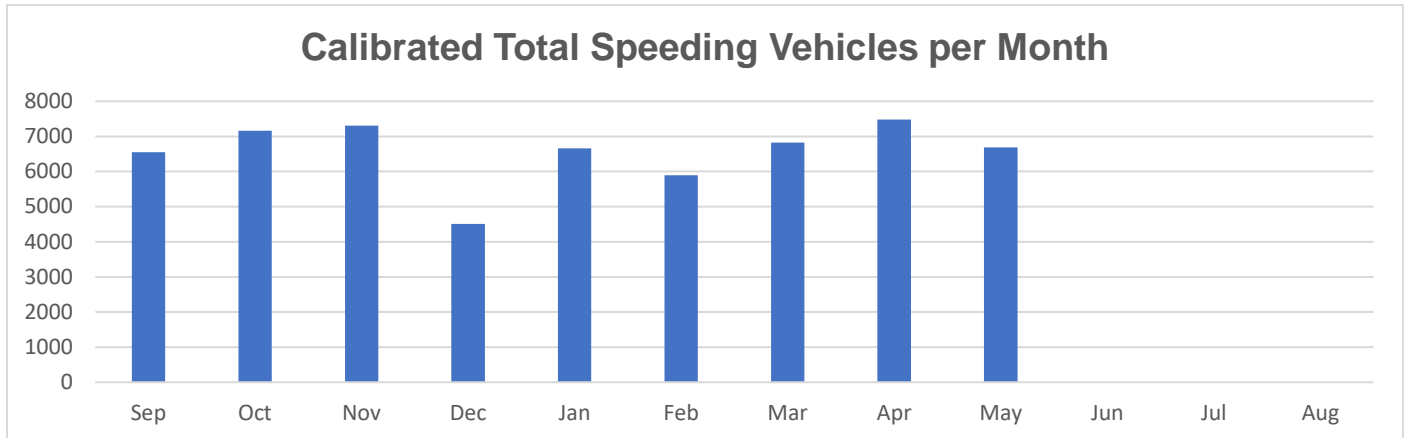


## Village Traffic and Roads Report

### Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) Report



The VAS calibration data for May was determined by a Black Cat session from 19/05/23 to 25/05/23.

The calibration value for speeders at 36mph and above is 5.77 and for excessive speeders 45mph and above is 6.29.

The number of speeding vehicles recorded was less than that for April but the same as for March. The number of excessive speeding vehicles is the highest since September, the start of this type of recording.

### **Black Cat Traffic Monitoring Device**

There were two Black Cat monitoring sessions carried out this month, one at Old Winders the other at Two Hoots.

For Two Hoots the total volume of traffic in the period 19/05/23 to 25/05/23 heading towards Rye was 19404 of which 4102 were speeding and 307 were speeding excessively, with an 85 percentile was 37.7 mph.

The total volume heading towards Beckley was 18974 of which 1557 were speeding and 127 were speeding excessively, with an 85 percentile of 33.8 mph.

For Old Winders the total volume of traffic in the period 27/05/23 to 02/06/23 (half term including a bank holiday), heading towards Peasmarsch was 19046 of which 263 were speeding and 7 were speeding excessively, with an 85 percentile of 38.77 mph. The total volume travelling towards Beckley was 13030 of which 114 were speeding and 4 were speeding excessively, with an 85 percentile of 38.33 mph.

Note the 85 percentiles in both directions is less than the speed limit of 40mph.

## Speed Watch

There were two speed watch sessions carried out in May and are summarised below.
