

## Village Traffic and Roads Report

## Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) Report





The VAS calibration data for June was determined by a Black Cat session this time last year. The calibration value for speeders at 36mph and above is 4.94 and for excessive speeders 45mph and above is 7.13.

The number of speeding vehicles recorded this month is the highest since the start of this type of recording. The number of excessive speeding vehicles is average since the start of this type of recording.
