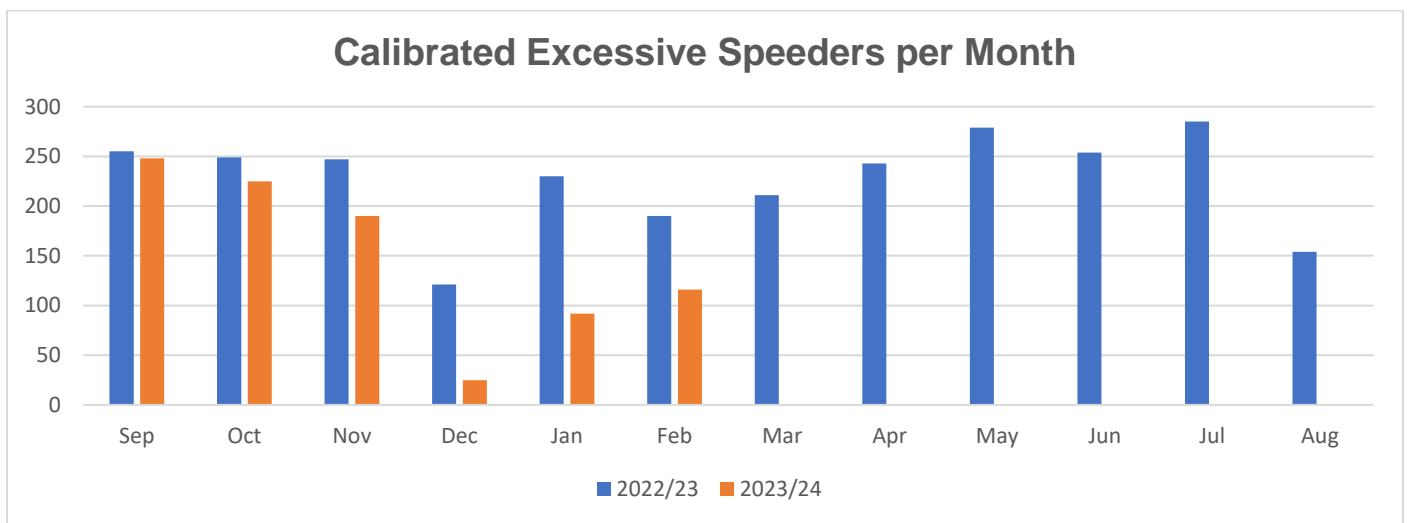
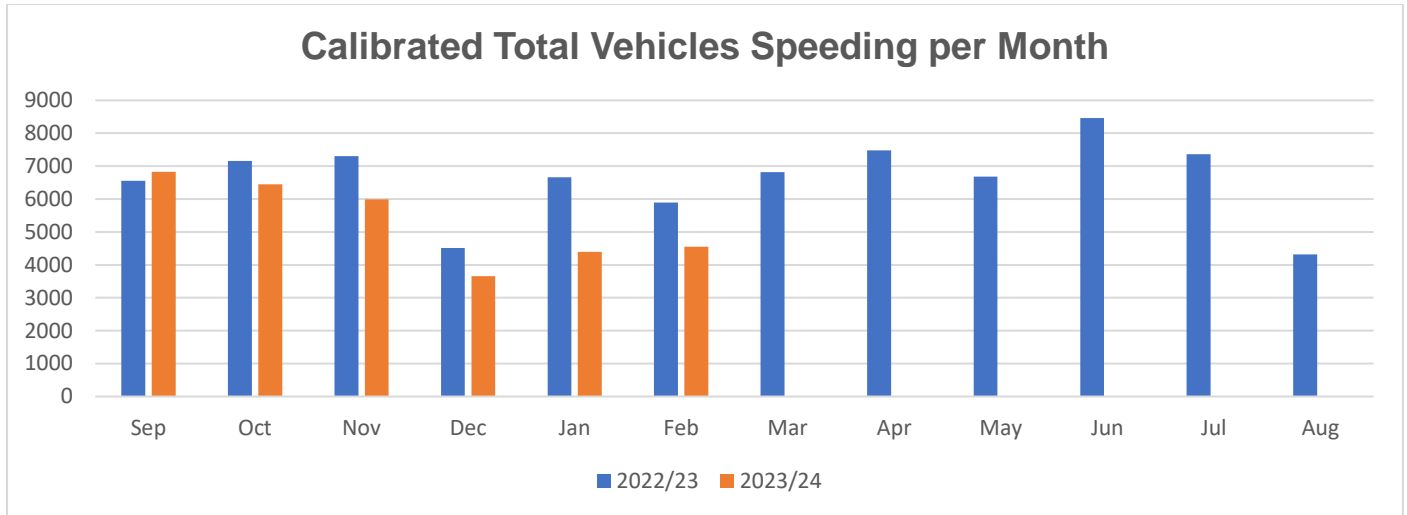


## Village Traffic and Roads Report

### Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) Report



The VAS calibration data for February was determined by a Black Cat calibration generated during the month. The calibration values previously were: 4.83 for vehicles over 35mph and 6.13 for vehicles over 45mph. The new values are: 5.25 and 6.65 respectively resulting in calibrated recordings of 4548 travelling more than 35mph and 116 speeding excessively.

### Black Cat Traffic Monitoring Device

There were two Black Cat monitoring surveys carried out in the period, the first at Two Hoots for VAS calibration purposes and the other at the bottom of School Lane during half term. This enabled the determination of the traffic volume along School Lane that is attributable to the school and is summarised below.
