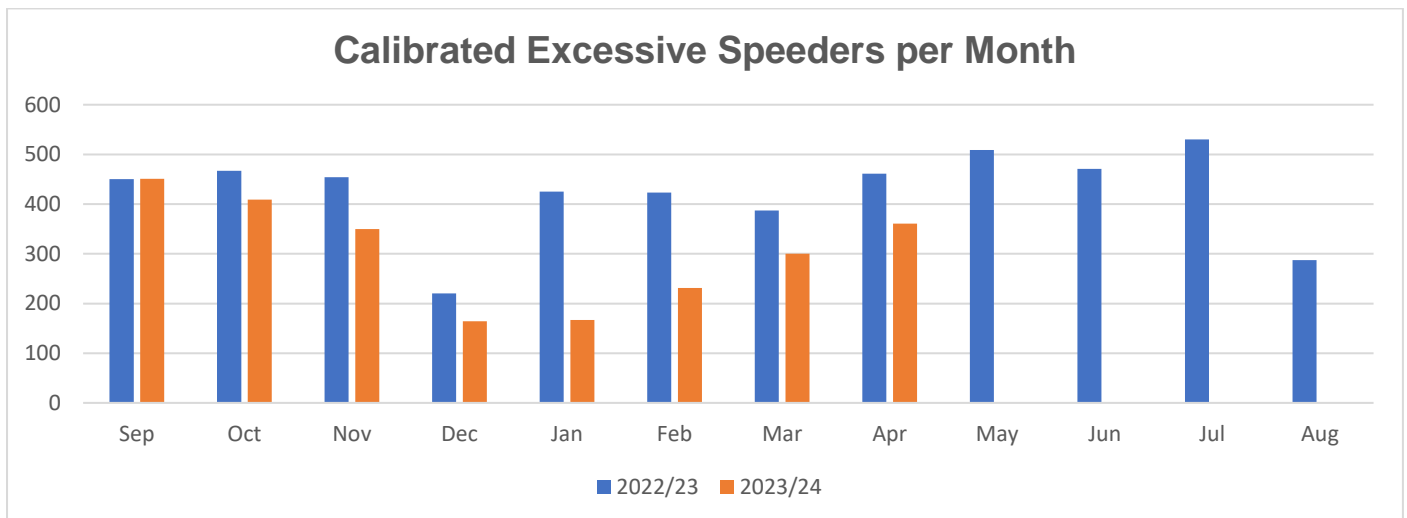
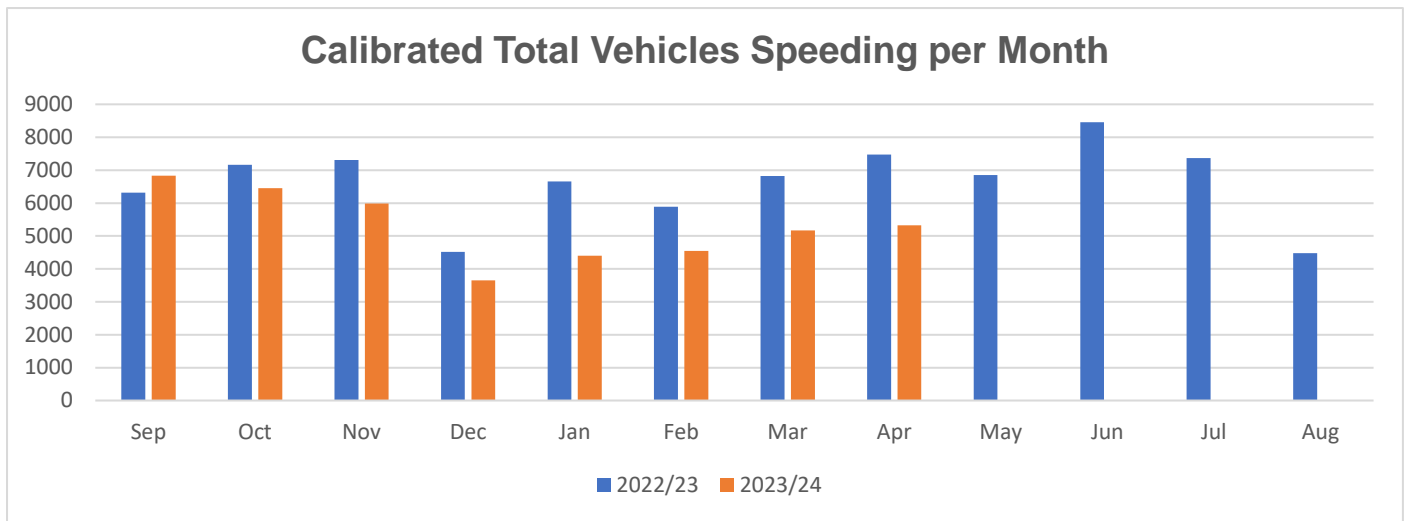


Village Traffic and Roads Report

Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) Report



I have rationalised the analysis software used to generate the VAS report removing redundant analysis which is now supplied by the Black Cat. As a result of this it was found that the volume of excessive speeding vehicles was being under reported. The charts above now reflect the updated values for the entire periods covered.

The Black Cat was used to provide an update to the calibration values for the month of April. The new values are: 5.48 for speeding vehicles and 5.66 for excessive speed. The calibrated total number of speeding vehicles recorded was 5322 of which 316 vehicles were speeding excessively.

At the April council meeting there was a discussion as to why there is now a sudden drop off in the number of speeding vehicles. It was suggested that this is due a reduction in traffic volume. The two Tables below would suggest this is not the case as the variation of speeding vehicles is greater than that for the total volume of vehicles.

Black Cat Traffic Monitoring Device

There was one Black Cat monitoring session carried out this month to provide calibration data for this month's VAS recordings. As April is a neutral month the 85 percentiles of speed can also be determined at Two Hoots. Towards Beckley it was, 34mph, towards Rye it was 37.8mph.
