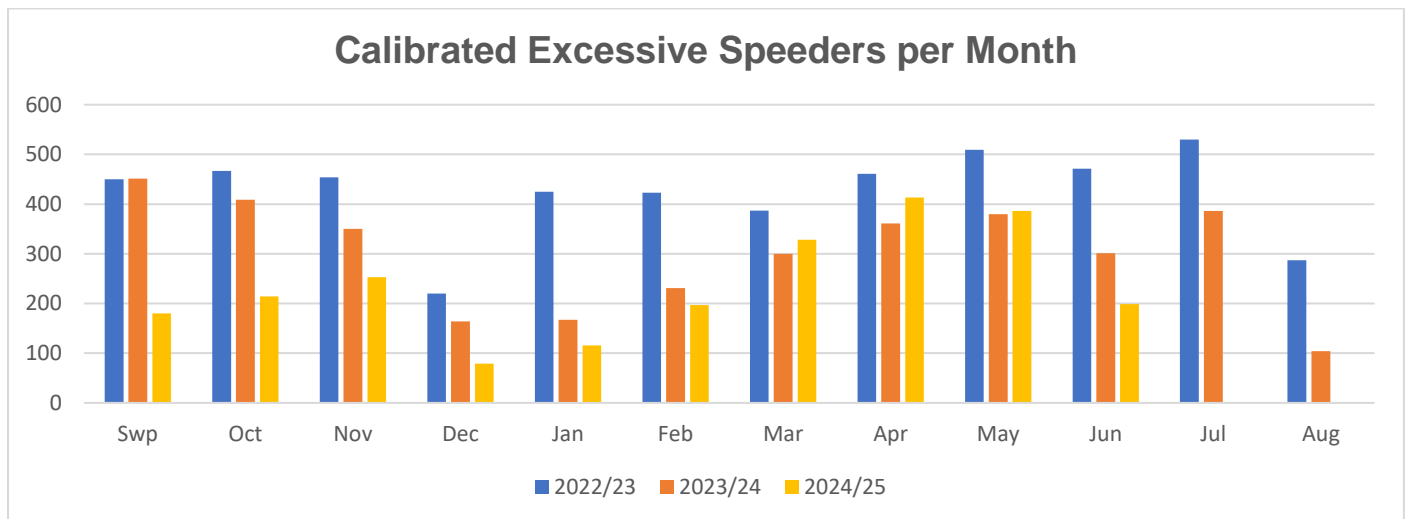
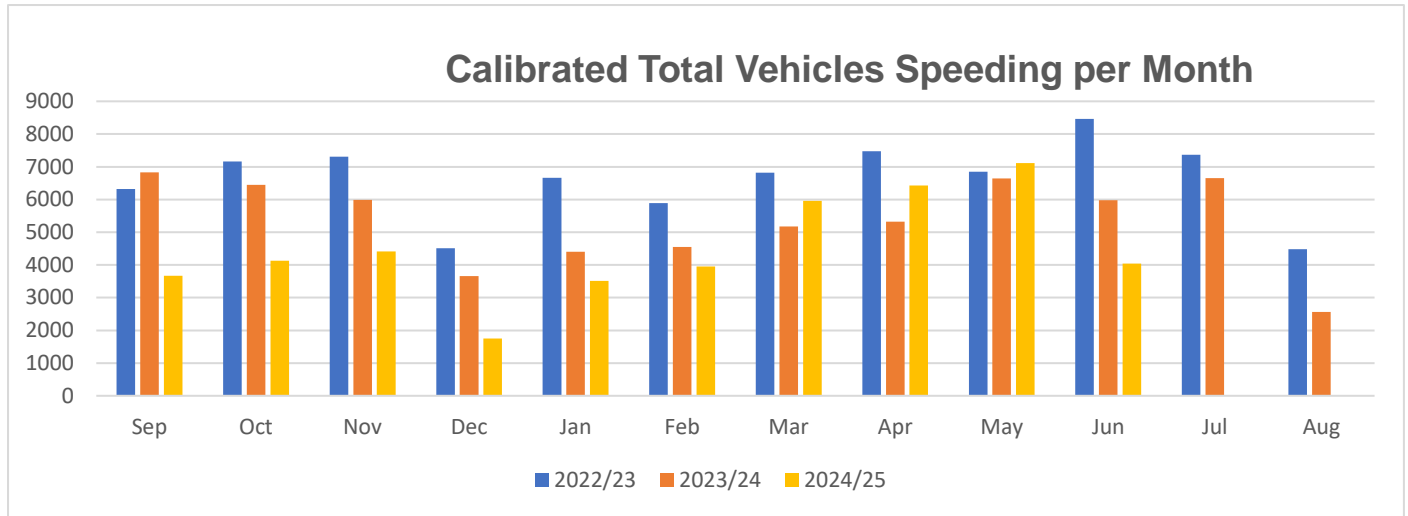


Village Traffic and Roads Report

Vehicle Activated Sign (VAS) Report



The VAS recorded 24506 speeding vehicles in June of which 1681 were speeding excessively. VAS calibration values that were determined for June last year were used this year; the values being 6.06 for speeding vehicles and 8.41 for excessive speeding, resulting in 4043 speeding of which 199 were excessive.

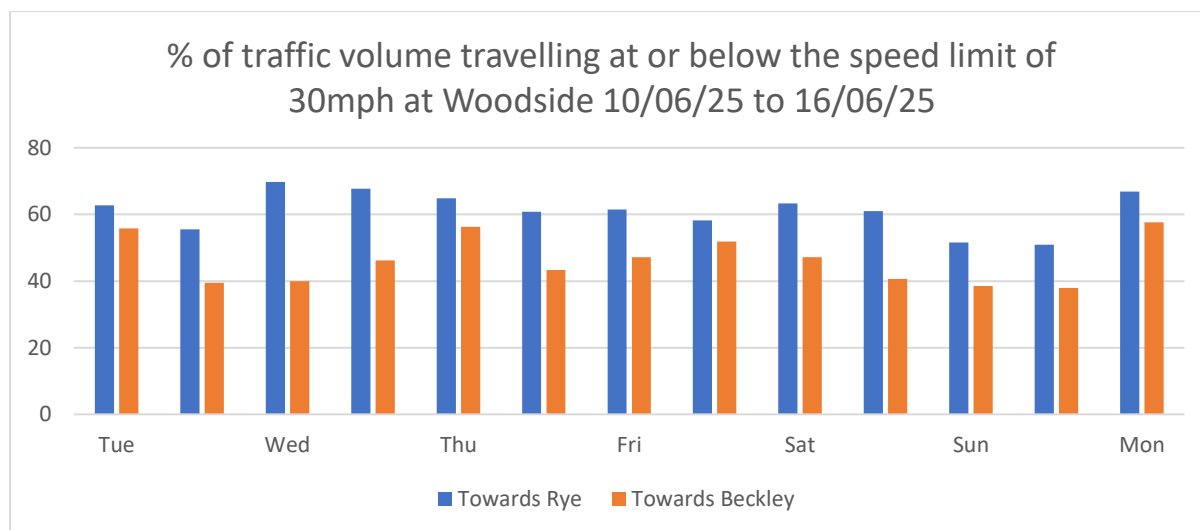
There was a decrease in recorded speeding vehicles of some 32.4% and excessive speeder by 34%. This reverses the trend of the previous three months.

Black Cat Traffic Monitoring Device

There was one Black Cat Monitoring sessions during the period 10/06/25 to 16/06/25 inclusive at the proposed Kitewood development junction with the A268. This point is where the speed limit changes between 30mph and 40mph by the Cock pub. At this point the speed limit is 30mph.

There was a total of 18527 vehicles heading towards Rye and 19779 heading towards Beckley recorded in the period. The 85 percentiles of speed recorded was 34.7mph towards Rye and 35.2mph towards Beckley.

The chart below shows the percentage of vehicles that were travelling within the speed limit during the periods when the 85 percentiles of speed were being measured.



Speed Watch
