We have completed 889 Carriageway Pothole Repairs between 01 July and 30 September in Rother, Bexhill, St Leonards and Hastings.

The Stewards and maintenance teams continue to be out on the Network completing inspections and repairs. Site visits are being carried out with individuals ensuring social distancing is in place and the team are attending SLR meetings remotely.
