RALC Report October 2021

Completed Potholes and Small Patching Works:

We have completed 1,050 carriageway pothole repairs between 01 July and 30 September in Rother, Bexhill, St Leonards and Hastings.

The spray patcher is continuing to carry out works across the County, since our last meeting they have carried out 22 days of works across Rother in the parishes of Icklesham, Northiam, Seddlescombe, Ticehurst and Westfield. We have also carried out small carriageway patching works at 14 sites in the towns and parishes in Rother, including Battle, Ninfield, Bodiam, Peasmarsh, Cock Marling, Rye Foreign, Brede, Salehurst, Camber, Dallington and Cripps Corner these were identified by your local Highway Stewards.

We monitor our repair standards through our own supervisor audits, as well as being audited by the ESCC Highway Team and joint audits to ensure our repairs meet the required standards.

Upcoming Works:

Our Preservation Programme of works has started across the county and includes roads in the Rother district. This preservation process involves spraying the road surface with a preservative treatment which contains gilsonite resin, a natural bitumen which seals and strengthens the road surface. The treatment stops further deterioration of the road surface and helps avoid the need for additional repairs for up to five years.
